Authorities said today they believe electrical problems caused the fire which killed a father and two daughters at 160 Parkside Ave. Kare County sheriff's police sold in Moscherville Friday morning.

Chief Don Hills said he believes the reason the victims were trapped was because a flexible line to a gas heater broke after the fire started, causing the fire to race through the bouse.
