Roomer Found Dead in Bed

Joseph Mihalizc, 62, roomer at
240 N Broadway, was found dead
in bed yesterday morning by an-
other roomer, Alex Kish. A physi-
cian summoned to examine Mi-
halizc shortly before 8 a. m. re-
ported that he had been dead for
about 10 hours when he was dis-
covered.

At an inquest held this morning
at the Healy chapel under the di-
rection of Coroner L. Victor Peter-
son the jury found Mihalizc's death
was caused by a heart attack.

Acquaintances of Mihalizc re-
ported that he had been in ill
health for several weeks but had
refused to see a physician. He was
born in Pinye, Sopron, Hungary,
on Aug. 31, 1887. None of his rela-
tives are believed to be in the
United States.
