Found Dead in City Jail Cell

Andrew Ramp, 62, of the Globe hotel, who was rescued from the Fox river Monday noon after he had fallen from an eight-foot retaining wall at the north tip of the island, was found dead in his cell in the city jail this morning by Charles Stolp, jailer. Ramp had been arrested and jailed after being rescued from the river by Gene Zefran, 1103 Homer avenue, and was charged with being intoxicated.

At 2 o'clock this morning, his cell mates, Leonard Thryselius and Jack Baker, related to Stolp, who discovered that Ramp was dead shortly after 6 o'clock this morning, that Ramp had complained of feeling ill when they talked with him. They had not talked with him, however, after they had helped him into his bunk.

An inquest into the death will be held tomorrow afternoon at 2:30 o'clock at the Daleiden mortuary.

Ramp, so far as can be learned, had been in Aurora since 1943 when he came here from Princeton where he had been employed as a section hand by the Burlington railroad.
