## Hangs Himself at County Home

Paul Zekeres, 77, formerly of 620  
North Root street, Aurora, took  
his life about 11:30 o'clock this  
morning by hanging himself in his  
room at the Kane county home  
where he had resided since 1936.

Zekeres accomplished his act of  
self-destruction by standing on a  
chair while securing a noose of bal-  
ing wire around his neck and on  
an overhead heating pipe. He left  
no note before stepping off of the  
chair to his death.

His body was discovered by Rob-  
ert A. Powell, superintendent of  
the county home, who notified the  
sheriff's office. Official investiga-  
tion was made by Deputy Charles  
Anderson. Coroner L. Victor Peter-  
son, of Elgin, was also notified and
