

**RESOLUTION 2016-15 AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP SUPERVISOR
TO DISPOSE OF SURPLUS PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, Aurora Township has twice sought public bids to dispose of surplus property – namely a 1990 International 3000 Series bus; and

WHEREAS, Aurora Township received no bids for the 1990 International 3000 Series bus at either of the bid openings held on February 11, 2016, and March 10, 2016; and


WHEREAS, the cost of legal advertisements alone has cost Aurora Township \$250.64 to date; and

WHEREAS, Kyle Martin, facilities manager at Fox Valley Christian Action (formerly known as Riverwoods camp), stated after the March 10 bid opening that he is willing to pay \$150 for the aforementioned bus; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Trustees of the Township of Aurora that the Township Supervisor is authorized to accept the offer of Kyle Martin and execute the necessary documents to perform the sale.

WHEREAS, the Aurora Township has determined that it is in the best interest of the Aurora Township to declare as surplus the vehicle, and


WHEREAS, the Aurora Township Board of Trustees is authorized to declare as surplus those items no longer deemed to be necessary to the Township service requirements.
