**RESOLUTION 2017 - 24**

**AUTHORIZING FUNDING FOR THE ASSOCIATION FOR  
INDIVIDUAL DEVELOPMENT**

WHEREAS, Aurora Township (the "Township") desires to support organizations that help disabled persons to remain independent; and


WHEREAS, the Township has a long history of partnering with the Association for Individual Development (the "Association") to support their work on behalf of residents with developmental disabilities in Aurora Township; and

WHEREAS, the Association has embarked on a capital campaign to retire debt owed on supportive living facilities they own including six properties in Aurora Township; and

WHEREAS, the Association has obtained a matching grant from the Dunham Fund up to \$750,000 over a three-year period for their capital campaign; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees authorizes a grant of \$35,000 to the Association for Individual Development which shall be paid as follows: \$10,000 for this fiscal year and \$12,500 for the following two fiscal years.


