RESOLUTION 2019 -22
GRANT FUNDING FOR 2019-2020 FISCAL YEAR

WHEREAS, Aurora Township (the “Township”) desires to support organizations that help senior citizens to remain independent and those that serve at-risk children; and

WHEREAS, the Township has a long history of partnering with Senior Service Associates, Inc., to support their work with senior citizens in the township and at their senior center, now at 2111 Plum Street, Aurora; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to continue to partner with Rebuilding Together Aurora to expand its current Safe at Home program for accessibility modifications and safety-related repairs for income-qualified residents in the unincorporated areas of Aurora Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township seeks to continue to partner with Living Daylight Organization to offer a summer STEM program for at-risk children at the Sagecrest Hills apartment complex, 1213 - 1215 Second Avenue, Aurora; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to partner with Accion Latina USA to support an anti-bullying program at its facility at 544 N. Lake Street, Aurora; and

WHEREAS, the Township seeks to partner with The Neighbor Project (formerly known as the Joseph Corporation) to support their major home repair and credit counseling services in the unincorporated areas of Aurora Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees authorizes a grant of \$20,000 to Accion Latina USA; \$15,000 to Senior Services Associates, Inc., \$10,000

to The Neighbor Project, \$6,500 to Living Daylight Organization and \$5,000 to Rebuilding Together Aurora.


