

RESOLUTION 2019 – 28
AURORA TOWNSHIP, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS
SENIOR SERVICES GRANT FUNDING
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020

WHEREAS, a majority of Aurora Township voters authorized the Aurora Township Board of Trustees (“Town Board”) to levy additional real estate taxes for the purposes of funding additional services for senior citizens in the elections held on March 20, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board voted in December 2018 to levy \$483,691 for additional services for senior services payable in 2019; and


WHEREAS, the Town Board approved Resolution 2019-07 creating and appointing members of the Aurora Township Senior Referendum Advisory Commission (“Commission”) to review funding applications and recommend allocations to the Town Board; and

WHEREAS, the Commission solicited funding applications this summer and met with agency representatives to discuss those applications.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Commission recommends that the Senior Service referendum funds for fiscal year 2019-2020 be granted to the following organizations as follows and the Township Board concurs with their recommendations:

Senior Services Associates \$300,000
The Association for Individual Development \$75,000
Marie Wilkinson Food Pantry \$50,000
Living Daylight Organization \$45,000
Aurora Township \$10,000


