**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUPERVISOR TO
EXECUTE RIDE IN KANE PACE SUBSIDY AGREEMENT**


WHEREAS, Aurora Township has provided and subsidized paratransit transportation for senior citizens and disabled persons for many years and finds it in the best interest of the public to continue providing and subsidizing this service; and

WHEREAS, these services are subsidized in part by the Suburban Bus Division of the Regional Transportation Authority, operating under the name of Pace; and

WHEREAS, Pace seeks to enter into an agreement with Aurora Township as part of the Ride in Kane program and released additional funding for a pilot program with the Visiting Nurse's Association.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Aurora Township Board of Trustees hereby authorizes and directs the Aurora Township Supervisor to execute a Ride in Kane Pace subsidy agreement for 2020.




**APPOINTING A MEMBER OF


