WHEREAS, the Township has a long history of partnering with Senior Services Associates, Inc., to support their work with senior citizens in the township and at their senior center, now at 2111 Plum Street, Aurora; and


WHEREAS, the Township desires to continue to partner with Rebuilding Together Aurora to expand its current Safe at Home program for accessibility modifications and safety-related repairs for income-qualified residents in the unincorporated areas of Aurora Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township seeks to continue to partner with Living Daylight Organization to offer a summer STEM program for 100 at-risk children who reside in Aurora Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township seeks to partner with The Neighbor Project (formerly known as the Joseph Corporation) to support their major home repair and credit counseling services in the unincorporated areas of Aurora Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees authorizes a grant of; \$15,000 to Senior Services Associates, Inc., \$10,000 to The Neighbor Project, \$6,500 to Living Daylight Organization and \$5,000 to Rebuilding Together Aurora.
