II. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING ON JANUARY 28, 2010.

1. There was a motion by Trustee Moore and seconded by Trustee Hicks to approve the Board of Trustees minutes from January 28, 2010. Motion carried by voice vote.

III. APPROVAL AND/OR AUDIT OF TOWNSHIP AND ROAD DISTRICT BILLS.

- 1. There was a motion by Trustee Catching and seconded by Trustee Moore to approve the **Township bills in the amount of \$44,031.14.** Discussion followed. Motion carried by voice vote.
