I. CALL TO ORDER

Supervisor Bill Catching called meeting to order at 3:30 p.m.

Supervisor Catching led the assembled in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Clerk Ken Christy called the roll. In attendance: Supervisor Bill Catching, Trustees Juan Reyna, David Moore, Juanita Wells, and Dolores Hicks. Also present were Road Commissioner John Shoemaker and Chief of Staff Patricia Richardson.

- II. Clerk Christy read the legal notices of purpose and dates of the Public hearing, as posted on April 9, 2015 in the Beacon News, a local newspaper of record, as required by law for both the Township and the Road District. Chief of Staff Patricia Richardson reviewed the proposed changes to the Township's posted tentative budget. The net effect of the changes was an increase in the projected ending fund balance of the Town Fund of \$1,500. The Board thanked Ms. Richardson for her hard work in the budget process.
