Full-Time Ride in Kane Driver

Basic Job Description

A Ride in Kane driver provides transportation for senior citizens and people with disabilities living in the Aurora Township area. In addition to driving a PACE [the suburban bus and regional paratransit division of the Regional Transportation Authority (RTA) in the Chicago metropolitan area] vehicle, physical duties will include boarding and alighting of the vehicle several times throughout the workday. This will be necessary to enhance safety of any passenger requiring assistance to and from the vehicle as well as boarding and alighting. Assisting passengers will also include securing wheelchairs and/or other types of mobility enhancing equipment, such as scooter, walkers, etc.

Aurora Township Ride in Kane drivers are required to pass the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) physical examination prior to being hired and each year thereafter while employed. Drivers are also required to obtain a CDL class "C" drivers license with a "P" endorsement, which must be kept up to date throughout their employment. While employed in this position, a driver is subject to the following drug tests: Annual, Post – Accident, Random, Reasonable Suspicion and Return to Duty/follow up.
