
AURORA TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING 80 N. Broadway, Aurora, Illinois Thursday, March 23, 2023 MINUTES



I. CALL TO ORDER
PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE
INVOCATION
ROLL CALL AND ESTABLISH QUORUM

Supervisor Bill Catching called the meeting to order at 4:05 p.m. and led all present in the Pledge of Allegiance. Trustee Hicks gave the invocation. Clerk Cassidy Alexander called the roll and established a quorum with the following officials and board members present: Supervisor Catching, Trustees Dolores Hicks, David Moore, Sam Núñez, Assessor Davis Offutt, and Highway Commissioner Jason Owens. Trustee Juanita Wells was excused absent. Staff present: Director of Finance and Administration Patty Richardson and Director of Community Services Ken Maurice. Public present: Dep. Brian Demeter of the Kane County Sheriff's Department, Dr. Peggy Hicks, Dornissa Gray, and Ivory and John Bird. NOTE: Trustee Sam Núñez was traveling for business and participated remotely via Zoom, and therefore all votes were by roll call.

III. Approval and/or Audit of Township and Road District Bills

a. Supervisor Catching moved to approve the combined Town Fund, Road and Bridge Fund, General Assistance Fund, Equipment & Building Fund, Town IMRF Fund, R&B IMRF Fund, Town Social Security Fund, and Road & Bridge Social Security Fund bills as presented to the board.
