RESOLUTION OF AURORA TOWNSHIP, ILLINOIS REGARDING FUNDS DULY APPROPRIATED FOR GOODS, SERVICES, OR PROJECTS BUT NOT PAID FOR DURING CURRENT BUDGET YEAR

KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS


WHEREAS, the Electors of Aurora Township, Illinois at the Annual Meeting of Aurora Township, held on April 9, 2024, have determined that sometimes funds which are appropriated for specific goods, services, or projects within a particular Highway Department budget year are not used until another budget year thus creating an excess in the first budget year; and

WHEREAS, these occurrences are within the normal course of business due to factors including but not limited to billing, supply issues, and projects that have not begun;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DECLARED by the Electors of Aurora Township, County of Kane, State of Illinois, as follows;

Funds that have been appropriated for payment of goods, services, or projects in a particular Highway Department budget year which are not used until another budget year are determined to be “roll overs” to pay those previously-budgeted expenditures and such “roll overs” are not to be considered hoarding of tax payer funds.

PASSED THIS 9th day of April, 2024 by the Electors duly assembled at the AURORA Township, KANE County, Illinois ANNUAL township meeting.




