AURORA TOWNSHIP, KANE COUNTY

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE DE FACTO RESIGNATION OF SHARAIN SPEARS

AND DECLARING THE VACANCY TO BE FILLED BY APPOINTMENT

WHEREAS, Sharain Spears was elected in the April 1, 2025, municipal election to the office of Township Trustee and has failed to take the oath of office; and,

WHEREAS, the Kane County State's Attorney has advised the Township that Spears is ineligible to hold the office of Township Trustee, and

WHEREAS, Aurora Township sent a registered letter via the United States Postal Service to Ms. Spears' address of record as filed with the Township Clerk on May 5 and has received no written response as requested;

WHEREAS, Ms. Spears did not attend the May 22, 2025, meeting of the Aurora Township Board of Trustees.

WHEREAS, in accordance with 60 ILCS 1/60-5, the Board shall fill the vacancy by appointment.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF AURORA TOWNSHIP, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, that:

Section 1. The Board hereby accepts the de facto resignation of Sharain Spears as a member of the Board of Trustees effective as of June 12, 2024.

Section 2. The Board hereby determines to fill the vacancy on the Board by appointment within sixty days after June 12, 2024.

Section 3. The Board shall appoint a successor who shall hold office for the remainder of the unexpired term of Spears.
